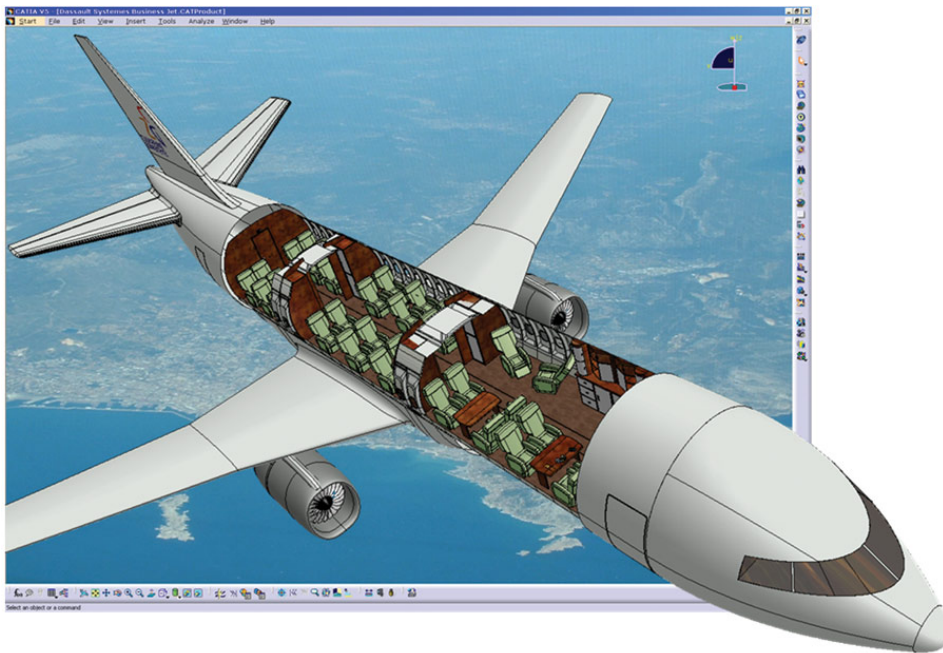


Comments from 2017 students

The study abroad to South Korea was an incredible experience over this summer.

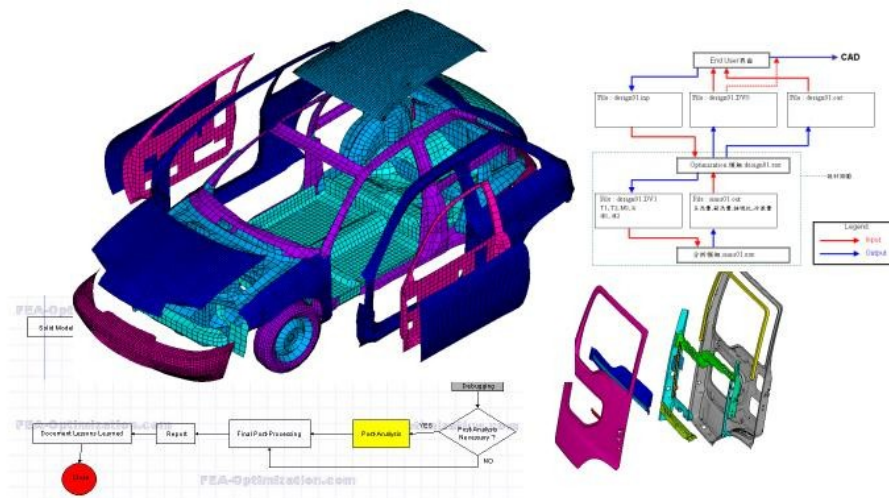
We learn how to use CATIA to draw 3D models; we learn how do stress analysis of an object using ABAQUS. Class was incredible and very interesting.
